Dr. Claudia Jonah, Kern County Health Officer, adds, “We are now making available the H1N1 Flu vaccine to the general public. However, we would like to remind everyone that the target groups for H1N1 remain:

Children 6 months to 24 years ;(10-24 years first & only dose needed and 9 years or younger first or second dose.)

- Pregnant Women;
- Caregivers of children 6 months of age and younger;
- Persons with Underlying Health Conditions 25 years to 64 years; and
- Healthcare Workers and Emergency Medical Workers.”

Public Health is planning more clinics through out Kern County and will release those dates and locations as details and vaccine are confirmed.
